

Lessons from New Orleans: A conversation with Education Activist Karran Harper Royal

10 years ago Hurricane Katrina destroyed much of New Orleans' infrastructure, including its public schools. Following the tragedy, NOLA schools were transformed almost overnight into an all-charter district.
